

Codicil to the Will of William Hale, dated 10th October 1828

This is a codicil to be taken and added to the last will and testament of me William Hale of the Parish of Saint John in the County of Hertford Gardener and Nurseryman which I make publish in the manner following Whereas I have by my said will bearing date thirteenth day of February One thousand eight hundred and twenty six given and bequeathed unto my two sons Samuel and Daniel Hale all of my stock out doors of fruit trees crops frames hand lights of every description whatsoever subject to their paying unto their mother Elizabeth Hale eight shillings a week that is to say Samuel Hale four shillings and Daniel Hale four shillings weekly during her natural life and to my daughter Naomi and my daughter Rebecca Ten pounds apiece in one year after my decease And whereas I have made no provision for my other children viz Thomas William Hannah the wife of William Cousins and Ruth the wife of James Field which I am desirous of doing NOW therefore I do by this codicil give and bequeath unto each of them my said four last mentioned children the sum of Seven pounds to be paid to each of them on the day of my funeral by my said two sons Samuel and Daniel Hale Also I give and bequeath unto each of my said four children the further sum of Twenty pounds to be paid to them respectively in one year after my decease by my said two sons Also I give and bequeath unto each of the children of my late daughter Elizabeth Chamberlain the sum of Ten pounds to be paid to them at their respective ages of twenty one years by my said two sons And I also hereby give unto my said two daughters Naomi and Rebecca the further sum of Ten pounds each in addition to the sum of Ten pounds given to them by my said will to be paid within one year of my decease and I hereby subject and charge all my said Stock in Trade Fruit Trees Crops Frames Hand Lights of every description with the payment of the said legacies by this my codicil bequeathed and in all other aspects I hereby satisfy and confirm my said will. In witness whereof I the said William Hale have hereunto set my hand and seal this Tenth day of October One thousand eight hundred and twenty eight.
