

Probate of John Troup of Clothall

By the Tenor of these presents We Richard Smith master of xxx commissary in that part of the Archdeaconry of Saint Albans which was lately in the Archdeaconry of Huntingdon And also Henry Maryells (Maryetts?) Clerk Master of xxxx Official in the part aforesaid and both lawfully constituted make known to all Men that on the seventh day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and fifty six before the Reverend John Smith Clerk Master of xxxx our Surrogate lawfully appointed

The last will and Testament of John Troup late of Clothall in the County of Hertford and part aforesaid Gardener deceased hereunto annexed was proved approved and registered and Administration of all and singular the goods Chattels and credits of the deceased and any nay (?) concerning his Will was granted to Jane Troup widow and Relict of the said deceased and sole Executrix named in the said will she having been already Sworn well and faithfully to administer the same and make a true and perfect Inventory of all and Singular the said Goods Chattels and Credits and to exhibit the same into the Registry of the part aforesaid on or before the last day of April next ensuing and also to render a just and true Account thereof (saving to everyone their right) Given at Hitchin under Our Seals of Office the day and year aforesaid.

Effects sworn under £1500 and that the Testator died on or about 8th day of December 1847.
